

Why and how to use **turnitin**[®] for university courses

turnitin[®] is an application to prevent and detect plagiarism.

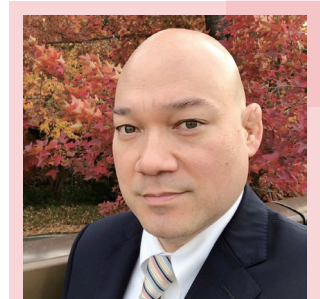
In this introductory workshop participants will be:

1. introduced to the *turnitin*[®] plagiarism application
2. provided with reasons for using the application in their courses
3. given an opportunity to create (or optionally observe the creation of) a *turnitin*[®] assignment in Moodle[®].

Participants will also receive an information packet that includes a *turnitin*[®] student similarity report (i.e. plagiarism report) with explanations and step-by-step graphic instructions on how to use *turnitin*[®] in Moodle[®].
