Profile

Mentored by Prof. Cusmano at Eiko Gakuen, he went on to School of Medicine, University of Tokyo; after clinical practice as pediatrician at hospital related to Department of Pediatrics, University of Tokyo, he taught residents as Assistant Professor at School of Medicine, University of Tokyo since 1995.

In 2001 he started his research on psychosomatic medicine as Assistant Professor at Harvard Medical School and conducted interdisciplinary research and educational activities also at MIT and Boston University.

He is now teaching and conducting research on developmental disorders and autonomic disorders at National Center for Child Health and Development, Department of Education and Department of Psychology of Meisei University. For the cities of Hachioji and Ome, he supervises the itinerant teaching service to support children with developmental disorders.
